

Constructed from hard-angled segments, the stylized "6" suggests both a secure perimeter and directional movement, like a forward-slash through signal space. The geometry echoes military glyphs while evoking AI logic blocks or threat vector paths. The logomark and wordmark lock up cleanly in vertical and horizontal formats, with "Actual." punctuated like a secure command-line statement. Its stark black-and-white form ensures high clarity across dashboards, comms, and gear, reinforcing Six Actual's mission: real-time, command-grade AI protection—delivered with sharp precision and trusted authority.



















This logo takes inspiration from digital instrumentation and hardware identifiers, using a segmented "6" reminiscent of military-grade displays or seven-segment numeric readouts. Encasing the mark in a rounded rectangle reinforces a sense of durability, like a shield or hardened module.
